The mission of the PCW is to bring the independent school community together to collaborate on timely issues affecting education, schools, students, and parents.



How Does PCW Benefit CHS Parents?

The PCW offers free and valuable resources to CHS parents, including:

- Two lectures each year, free to member school parents, presented by prominent experts on education and parenting.
- An annual “best practices” forum in which member schools collaborate on their approaches to a timely issue (recent topics have included Diversity, Students and Stress, and Encouraging Kindness in Schools). PCW publishes an online E-binder summarizing the “best practices” recommendations that emerged.
- “Parent Speak,” a moderated forum in which member school parents are invited to share their perspectives in an open and frank exchange of ideas on parenting issues.
- Extensive website resources at www.parentscouncil.org, such as archived summaries of prior PCW programs, Best Practices e-binders, and lists of books and websites relating to a wide array of education and parenting topics.

The Parents Council of Washington (PCW) is a consortium of almost 60 independent schools in the greater Washington, D.C. area. Concord Hill School is a member school and assigns parent representatives to the PCW.
